

Fuzzy Mud (700L) (W) by Louis Sachar

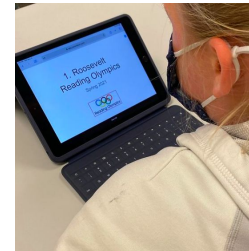
